



Tansor Playgroup Prospectus 2022

We are a small playgroup in a village location that takes pre-school children from 2 years old up to school age. We run eight x 3hr sessions each week during the Northamptonshire school term times, together with the option for earlier drop-offs or later pick-ups on certain days.

Tansor Playgroup has been in existence for over 40 years, and we have established an excellent reputation as a provider of Early Years education. Our team of experienced, friendly, and qualified staff are passionate about providing excellent childcare for pre-schoolers. We deliver the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum by encouraging learning through exploration and play. We can provide a wide range of opportunities for children in the important pre-school years within a supportive, happy, and stimulating environment.

Session Information

Core Session Times

Our core session times are Monday - Friday 9am-12pm, plus Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday afternoons from 12-3pm, giving the option of a full day on those days if desired. We also offer the option for those children that would like to remain for lunch on a Monday, Tuesday & Wednesday, but not stay for the full afternoon session, to stay on to eat their lunch with the others from 12-1pm.

This gives a total of 24 hours per week that can be claimed via either the Universal 15 hours Free Entitlement for 3- and 4-year-olds, or the Extended 30 hours Childcare for working parents of 3 and 4 year olds. For more details, please see the section headed Free Childcare Entitlement.

Extended Hours – Early Drop-Off / Late Pick-Up (currently these are not being offered due to low demand. Please register an interest if you would use early drop off or late collection)

We also offer an optional 8.30am early drop-off and a 3.30pm late pick-up on certain days. Early drop-offs are available on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Fridays, plus Thursday mornings when sessions are held at Tansor Village Hall (i.e. November – April).

Late pick-ups are available on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays.

We require parents who want to make use of these extended hours to sign up in advance per term, as they will only be run if there is sufficient demand, though we may be able to consider ad-hoc attendance in exceptional circumstances.

Outdoor Sessions – Thursday mornings 9am – 12noon

Our popular outdoor sessions run every Thursday morning from after Easter until October half term. These are located in our woodland classroom setting, hosted by the Wildlife Trust at Glapthorn Cow Pasture Nature Reserve. Places on these sessions are currently only available to children aged 3yrs+. Children under 3yrs of age are however very welcome to attend Thursday morning sessions when they are relocated back to Tansor Village Hall from the October half-term until the following Easter.

Drinks and Snacks

Drinks and healthy snacks are provided at all sessions. Children attending an afternoon or lunch session need to bring a packed lunch with them from home to eat at the start of the session at 12 noon. We have a strict no nut policy for lunches due to allergies in the Playgroup.

Location

Sessions are held at Tansor Village Hall which can be found at the very end of the Main Street in Tansor. The postcode is **PE8 5HS**. Between Easter and late October, our Thursday morning sessions are held in the woods at Glapthorn. Thursday morning sessions resume at Tansor Village Hall during the winter months.

Session Rates

Our fees are £16.50 per 3-hour session i.e. 9am-12pm or 12pm-3pm.

Lunch-only sessions 12-1pm on a Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday are £5.50 per session if your child is **not** then staying on for the full afternoon session.

*Extended sessions: 8.30am early drop-off / 3.30pm late pick-up = £3.50 per 30 minutes.
(*currently not on offer due to low demand)

For example:

3hrs: 9am-12pm or 12-3pm: £16.50

4hrs: 9am-1pm: £22.00

6hrs: 9am-3pm: £33.00

3hrs plus early drop-off or late pick-up: 8.30am-12pm or 12pm-3.30pm: £18.50

6hrs plus early drop-off and late pick-up: 8.30am-3.30pm: £37.00

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We accept payment by cheque, bank transfer, employer childcare vouchers, and the Government's tax-free childcare voucher scheme.

Fees are invoiced in full at the start of each term, and payment is required within 14 days. We can accept monthly payments if preferred – please contact us to discuss further.

Free Childcare Entitlement

All parents of 3- and 4-year-old children are able to claim free childcare entitlement for their children.

Parents of 2-year-old children may also be able to claim free childcare depending on their situation and the needs of their child.

Universal 15 hours Free Entitlement for 3- and 4-year-olds.

All 3–4-year-olds are eligible for 570 hours a year of funded childcare known as the free entitlement. Funding is spread across three funding blocks a year, up to a maximum of 15 hours a week if the hours are taken during school term times (over 38 weeks). Children are eligible from the first full funding block following their 3rd birthday.

The funding blocks run from:

1st September to 31st December

1st January to 31st March

1st April to 31st August

For example: A child born on the 3rd of February would be eligible from the 1st April following their 3rd birthday.

You may choose for your child to take all or part of their free entitlement at a maximum of two childcare providers.

To access this funding, you must complete a parental contract at the start of each term, and provide evidence of your address and proof of your child's identity. Funding will then be claimed by Tansor Playgroup for your child.

Any attendance at Tansor Playgroup over the free entitlement hours will be charged at the current session rates. (It is not possible to use funded hours for the 30 minute 8.30am early drop-off and 3.30pm late-pick up sessions. These 30 minute sessions will be charged at the rates shown above. However as mentioned previously these are currently not on offer due to low demand.)

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Extended 30 hours Childcare for working parents of 3 and 4 year olds

The free childcare offer has been increased from 15 hours to 30 hours a week for families where both parents are working (or in the case of sole parents where that sole parent is working). The purpose of the increased childcare offer is to support working parents with childcare costs. The funding is available to children in the first full funding block following their third birthday.

There is a simple online eligibility checker that you can complete to see if you are eligible. Please visit <https://www.gov.uk/apply-30-hours-free-tax-free-childcare> and follow the online instructions.

Parents must reconfirm their eligibility on a three-monthly basis. If your circumstances alter and you are no longer eligible then there will be a grace period before the child's funding ends in order to help the child, family and provider to manage the change. Important:

To claim extended hours funding you will need to have registered and had your eligibility confirmed by the end of the month prior to the start of the funding block. For example:

To claim funding in this block:	Eligibility must be confirmed by:
1 st January - 31 st March	31 st December
1 st April – 31 st August	31 st March
1 st September – 31 st December	31 st August

Any attendance at Tansor Playgroup over the extended free childcare hours will be charged at the current session rates. Free childcare and education for 2 year olds

If you are the parent/carer of a 2 year old and receive certain benefits, your child could be eligible for free childcare and education. To find out if you qualify for this funding, please use the simple online eligibility checker at www.northnorthants.gov.uk/2yearfunding

(Outdoor sessions from mid-April – end Oct are solely for children aged 3yrs+. From November - Easter these sessions are open children aged 2yrs+)

Children may attend a combination of sessions – mornings, afternoons, mornings with lunch, or all day. To ensure that each child settles well, children must attend for a minimum of 2 sessions / 6 hours per week. In the event of a session becoming fully subscribed, we operate a waiting list system for any available vacancies.

Information we hold about you and your child

We have procedures in place for the recording and sharing of information about you and your child that is compliant with the principles of the General Data Protection Regulations (2018) as follows:

The data we collect is

1. Processed fairly, lawfully and in a transparent manner in relation to data subject

5. Kept in a form which permits identification of you and your family for no longer than is necessary for the purposes for which the personal data is processed.
6. Processed in a way that ensures appropriate security of the personal data, including protection against unauthorised or unlawful processing and against accidental loss, destruction, or damage, using appropriate technical or organisational measures.

The Management of our Setting

Tansor Playgroup is a registered charity and is overseen by a management committee of dedicated local parent volunteers.
